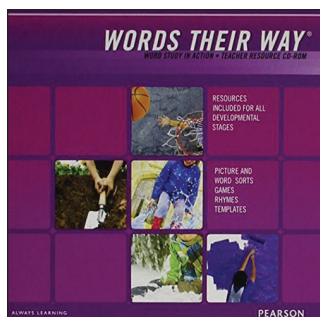
Overview
